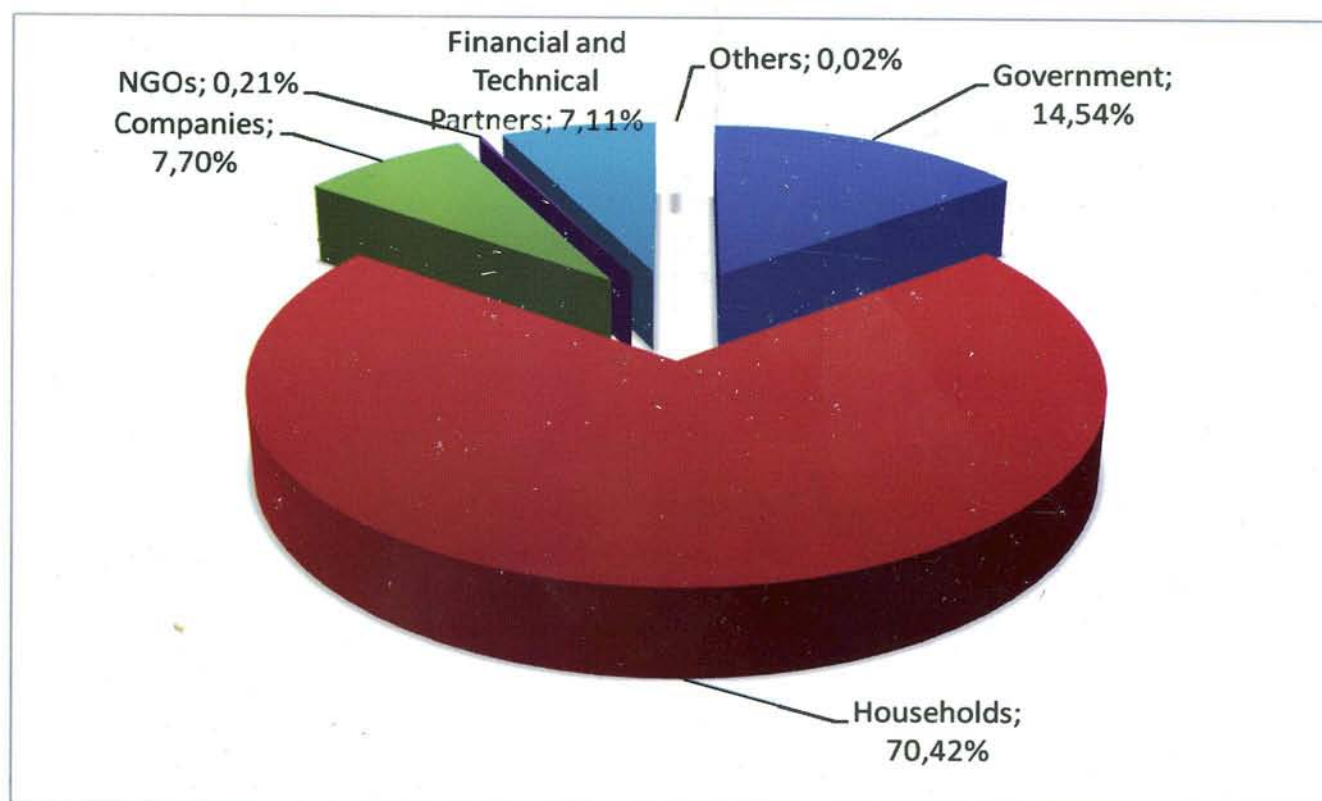

What is the global volume of health expenditure in 2012?

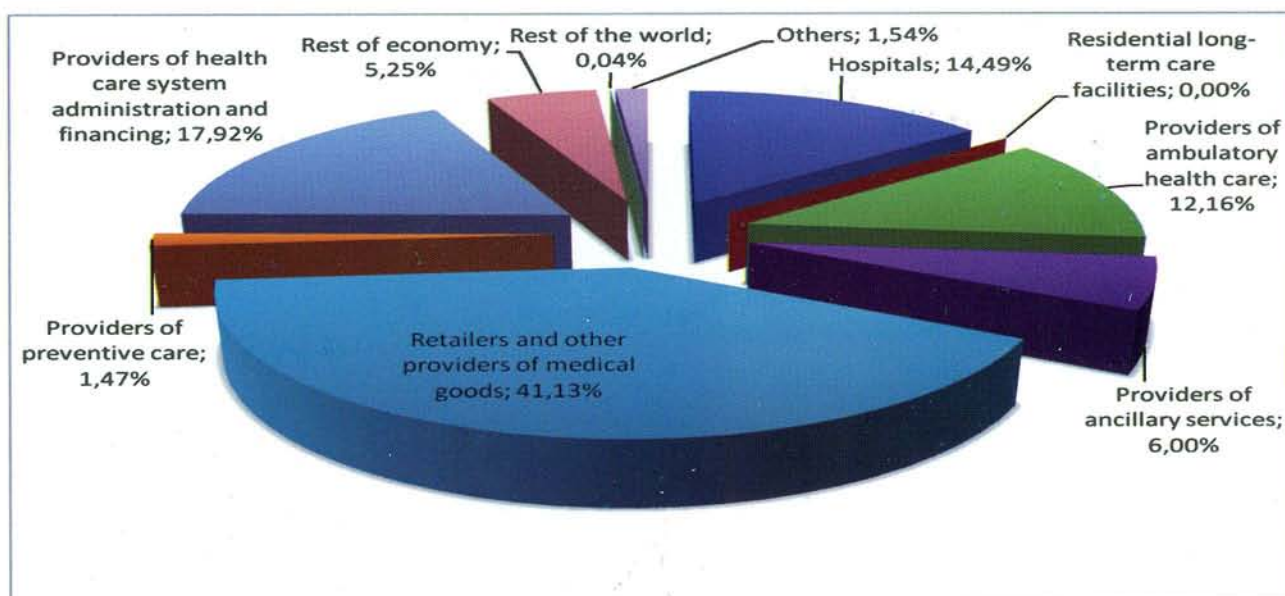
The total volume of health expenditure in 2012 amounts to **FCFA 728.1 billion** representing 5.4% of the actual GDP. This global health expenditure is distributed as follows: **FCFA 674.882 billion** in current health expenditure and **FCFA 53.226 billion** in capital expenditure. This corresponds to **FCFA 32 703 per capita** in 2012. The National Health Accounts analysis concerns only current resources to the tune **FCFA of 674.882 billion**.

In 2012, households expenditure for health per capita stood at FCFA 23 261. Douala and Yaounde present the highest ratios, FCFA 47 801 and FCFA 41 835, respectively. The West and Adamawa Regions, respectively hold the third (FCFA 27 661) and fourth (FCFA 23 041) highest ratios followed by the Centre (FCFA 18 739) and Littoral (FCFA 18 884) Regions, Yaounde and Douala. With its large population (3 669 624 inhabitants), the Far-North Region records the lowest ratio for health expenditure for households per capita (FCFA 10 465).
